To participate in this program you must:

- ✓ Be between the ages of 8 and 18 as of 12/31/19
- ✓ Enroll in the Boulder County 4-H Program
- ✓ Join a 4-H Club and fulfill all requirements
- ✓ Complete the Lease-An-Animal Application
- ✓ Spend a minimum of 6 hours each month working with your animal
- ✓ Attend a Colorado 4-H MQA training on animal husbandry and safety
- ✓ Maintain your record book
- ✓ Display or show your animal once during the year
