1. What is the main function of carbohydrates in a dog's diet? Pg. 160 (old book pg. 157)

A: To provide the dog with energy.

2. For what purpose were the Toy breeds of dogs developed? Pg. 19 (old book pg. 20)

A: To provide pleasure and companionship to their owners.

3. What type of bite does a Shih Tzu have? Pg. 23 (old book pg. 23)

A: Undershot bite.

4. What can happen if a dog eats grapes or raisins? Pg. 164 (old book pg. 162)

A: Grapes and raisins contain a toxin that can damage a dog's kidneys, leading to renal failure and death.

5. What is an Otter Tail? Pg. 25 (old book pg. 25)

A: A tail that is thick at the base, round and tapering, with the hair parted or divided on the underside.

6. How do you determine a dog's jump height? Pg. 86 (old book pg. 83)

A: With the dog standing, measure from the top of the dog's withers to the floor.

7. What is the normal body temperature for a dog? Pg. 141 (old book 141)

A: 100.5 F – 102.5 F.

8. What type of hair coat is found in the Puli, Komondor, and Poodle? Pg. 30 (old book pg. 30)  
A: Curly coat.
  
9. What body parts comprise a dog's Backline? Pg. 130 (old book pg. 129)  
A: Back, Loin, Croup.
  
10. What kind of tissue attaches the dogs' forequarters to the body? Pg. 27 (old book pg. 27)  
A: Muscle tissue.
  
11. What breed of dog is stacked differently from all other breeds? Pg. 103 (old book pg. 101)  
A: German Shepard.
  
12. What does the term "zoonotic disease" refer to? Pg. 152 (old book pg. 152)  
A: Diseases that can be passed from animals to humans or humans to animals.
  
13. What is the function of a dog's anal glands? Pg. 153 (old book pg. 152)  
A: They enable a dog to mark territory and identify other dogs.
  
14. What is the purpose of styptic powder? Pg. 33 (old book pg. 33)  
A: Quickly stops bleeding caused by accidentally cutting into the quick.
  
15. What is the female parent (mother) of a litter of puppies called? Pg. 12 (old book pg. 13)  
A: A Dam
  
16. What external parasite from the arachnid family causes skin irritation and disease? Pg.150 (old book pg. 149)  
A: Mites
