500 Word Essay which includes how your 4-H background and school career has prepared you for post high school learning. Include the most worthwhile accomplishments and benefits through your 4-H program, including project development and leadership activities.

Copy of acceptance letter from college/university/trade school, etc. If current college student, transcript

Do not modify form or leave spaces blank - every box must be completed. Attach only required items

On the 4-H Participation sheet make sure you mark everything you have been involved in

Proofread your application

In Addition:

Review all of the scholarships and their requirements (on the website). Mark all those scholarships for which you qualify

Late applications will not be considered. Make sure application is turned in by the deadline date - April 1st at 4:30pm SEND TO: boulder4hlegacyfund@gmail.com and cc yourself so that you can verify what was sent. We will confirm receipt of your application. After the deadline of April 1 we will schedule interviews. Please check your email spam/junk folders to ensure you are not missing correspondence from us.
