~ **Friends and Family Class rules:** 2 entries, same horse and tack. Rider one judged 1st direction, all riders called to center where riders will change. Riders can adjust only stirrups. Rider Two judged 2nd direction.

~ In the 4-H classes, Exhibitors enrolled in a 4-H Horse Project show their own project horse(s) & compete at their current 4-H riding level

~ There will be Boulder County 4-H HLC High Points awarded toward year-end high point awards for classes marked with (\*\*). See County High Point Rules for details.

~ **Helmets are REQUIRED for all Walk/Trot thru Level I Riders & recommended for all others.**

~ Management may elect to combine classes with 3 or fewer entries or split classes with a lot of entries.

~ Barn C is available to use for riders/horses waiting between classes

~ Age as of December 31, 2023 and youth must be 8 years old to participate.

~ Open Youth classes are for ages 8-18.

~ Open Adult classes are for ages 19+
