To determine who qualifies for the State Fair competition we will be having county shoot-offs at the following times and locations. **There will be a REQUIRED pre-registration for all disciplines by July 8, 2024 except for Trap and Skeet/5 Stand. Shotgun pre-registrations will be due July 22, 2024. Registering your project and record book into Fair Entry DOES NOT mean you are pre-registered for the county shoots.** Please make sure you do both. Links to pre-registration forms are included in each discipline's information blocks below. **Late registrations will NOT be accepted** Details on each county shoot are below.

We encourage all 4-H members that are enrolled in the Shooting Sports Program to come and enjoy the Boulder County competitions. Participating in the Boulder County Shoot-Offs does not count towards completion of your shooting project. If you are uncomfortable (for any reason) with participating in the in-person county shoot-offs, we encourage you to still complete your project (poster board or standalone) and record book and enter them into the Boulder County Fair at Interview Judging Day, August 1, 2024. Registration links for Interview Judging Day will be sent out later.

If you do qualify for a state team and you do not want to participate in the Colorado State Fair Shooting Sports contest you must tell the superintendent at the time of qualifying.

All shooters have been charged a yearly one-time fee of \$20.00. This \$20.00 covers the cost of all shooting events, except shotgun range fees. Shooting Sports fees **MUST** be paid prior to County Shoot Offs. If fees are not paid prior to the shoot offs the 4-H member will not be allowed to participate in the County Shoots. Please see attached Boulder County Shooting Sports Addendum item #14. All participants will receive a t-shirt (if fees were paid prior to t-shirt order being placed). Due to an increase in Colorado State Shooting Contest fees, there will be an additional one-time fee of \$20.00 for those 4-H members attending the Colorado State Shooting Contest. The \$20.00 fee must be paid at the county shoot off by those 4-H members accepting a position on a state team. Please see the attached Boulder County Shooting Sports Addendum Items 14 & 15 for further information on all Shooting Sports fees.

To participate at the Boulder County Shoot-offs you **MUST** have practiced at least five (5) **SAFE** times in each discipline that you shoot, with a certified Boulder County shooting sports leader by check in of each County Shoot Off. A practice card showing all five safe practices, plus a safety training, verified by signatures from a Boulder County Certified Shooting Sports leader, **MUST** be presented at each county shoot off. Please see attached Boulder County Shooting Sports Addendum item #6.

Completion of a Hunter Safety Class is required to participate in a Boulder County Shoot-off. You **MUST** bring your Hunter Safety Card with you to **EACH** shoot-off for inspection upon request. **All Hunter Safety**

Cards must be upload to your 4honline accounts. Currently, you are not able to upload your cards. Please email a PDF or photo of your card to Lisa Wallace lwallace@bouldercounty.org to be uploaded. All Boulder County shoot-offs will be Conducted using the Colorado State Fair Contest rules found at <https://co4h.colostate.edu/ss/ss-rulebook.pdf>

To be eligible to represent Boulder County as a member of a State Fair Team and win an end of the year shooting sports award, a member **MUST** submit for review, a record book and display project at or prior to Interview Judging day. If a member is enrolled in more than one shooting sports discipline, only one record book and project are required. Interview Judging day is August 1, 2024. More information on Interview Judging Day will be coming. Please see attached Boulder County Shooting Sports Addendum item #4.

Due to the set-up of the 3-D shoot, ENTRANCE to the IA will be the small SE entry door (by office) for IA for all check in; safety meeting, use of restrooms, FITA shooting, and Award announcements.

Once the shooters have completed the FITA portion the same relay will have a 15 min break before beginning the 3-D portion. Announcement of placings will follow the completed Archery Shoot in the IA

Members will shoot 3 rounds of both Skeet and 5 Stand. Scores for 5 Stand will not be advanced into the Colorado State Fair Shooting Contest. Each participant needs to bring his/her own shotgun, at least 75 shotgun shells per game (shot size 7.5,8 or 9) extra shells for possible tie breaker shoot off, safety glasses and ear protection. Everyone should plan to shoot three (3) rounds of Skeet and three (3) rounds of 5 Stand and your two best scores will be used as your final score. The third round will be used as the first tiebreaker. The cost will be \$21.00 for 3 rounds of Skeet and \$27.00 for 3 rounds of 5 Stand. Berthoud Gun Club – 20498 Weld County Rd 1, Berthoud. Located ½ mile south of Hwy 56 on Road 1.

Great Guns Sporting LLC – 16126 WCR 96, Nunn, CO, Nunn is located on Hwy 85 north of Ault. Take I-25 North to Hwy 14. Take Hwy 14 east until Ault. Go North on Hwy 85 to WCR 94. Note WCR 94 is North of Pierce, but South of Nunn. Go East on WCR 94 for about .5 mile and turn left on WCR 33 for 1 mile, then go right on WCR 96 about .5 miles to the Great Guns Sporting Club.
