~ Management may elect to combine classes with 3 or fewer entries or split classes with a lot of entries.

~ Barn C is available to use for riders/horses waiting between classes

~ Age as of December 31, 2024 and youth must be 8 years old to participate.

~ Open Youth classes are for ages 8-18.

~ Open Adult classes are for ages 19+
