JUST A FEW RULES:

- **Attire:** ASTM certified safety helmets, with harness buckled securely, are **required** for all mounted events, for **walk/trot riders, Unrated and Level I** riders. This includes but is not limited to shows, rideouts, warm up arenas and clinics. Helmets are highly encouraged to be worn by all riders in all disciplines.
- Boots, long pants and shirts (with sleeves) required for all classes.
- **Age:** Age of rider is determined by rider's age on 12-31-2025
- **Tack:** Horses must be shown in legal tack appropriate for each class.
- **All classes in the schooling show** are open to participants 8 and over.
- Classes with 3 or fewer entries may be combined, and large classes may be split at the discretion of show management.
- **No stallions** allowed on show grounds (colts under 1 year old are allowed).
- **No dogs** allowed in the indoor arena.
- **NO Refunds on scratches**
- **4-H Rules** will be followed

SCHOOLING SHOW CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Demo classes: Classes 1, 6 and 21 will be exhibitors who have been showing horses for 4+ years. It is our hope that newer exhibitors will watch these classes to get an idea of what the class should look like, to enhance their learning experience.

Do Over classes: Classes 2, 8, 10, 15, 23 and 25 will be exhibitors who have been showing 3 or fewer years. The class procedure will be as follows: all exhibitors will demonstrate the posted pattern; Judge will give feedback to each exhibitor with tips to improve; class will be re-run to give exhibitors a chance to implement Judge's suggestions. Placings will be awarded based on the second round of patterns.

"Parents" Classes: Open to any parent of a 4-H member, past or present!

English and Western Training Tack: Humane training tack is allowed. The judge's opinion is final concerning the use of questionable tack.

Stick Horse Class: This class is open to ALL ages. Bring your own stick horse, or catch-ride one of ours!
