

Animal Science Discovery – Display Board

This is a pilot Colorado 4-H project where 4-H members learn about an animal species of their choice, except for Cat and Horseless Horse, which have their own projects. This could include youth that are not showing an animal or who want to extend their learning beyond raising and showing an animal. Curriculum for this project includes all the existing Livestock and Dog manuals from The Ohio State or Pet Pals and Wildlife Science manuals available from Shop 4-H.
