COLORADO & BOULDER COUNTY 4-H HORSE SHOW RULES APPLY

- All classes marked "4-H" qualify for the Boulder County 4-H HLC year-end high point award.
- **ASTM certified safety helmets**, with harness buckled securely, are **required** for all mounted events, for **walk/trot riders, Unrated, Level I** and for **ALL gymkhana** riders. Helmets are highly encouraged to be worn by all riders in all disciplines.
- Age of rider is determined by rider's age on 12-31-2025
- 4-H Exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H Horse Project this year, must show their own project horse(s), and must compete at their 4-H riding level test passed.
- "Parents" showmanship class is for current and past parents of 4-H members
- **Entries in Walk/Trot-Jog classes may not also participate in any class that canters or lopes.**
- Miniature horses must not exceed 40"
- Management may elect to combine classes with 3 or fewer entries or split large classes.
- **Friends and Family Class #39 rules:** Requires 2 entries, same horse and tack, and riders shall wear the same back number. Rider one is judged 1st direction, all riders called to center where riders will change. Riders can adjust only stirrups. Rider two is judged 2nd direction. When you sign up please let us know who you are paired with!
