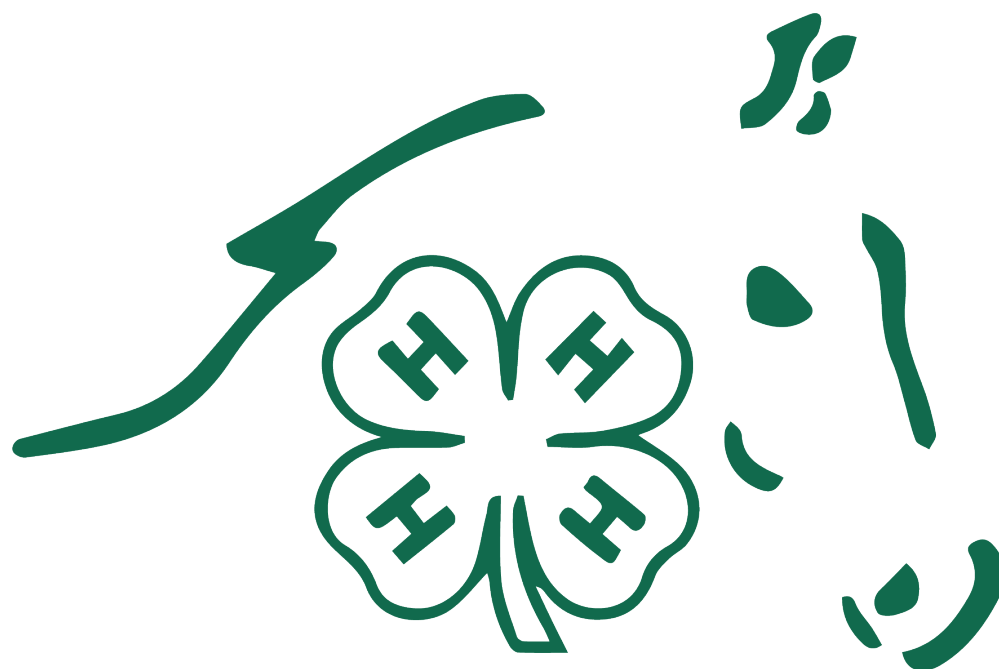


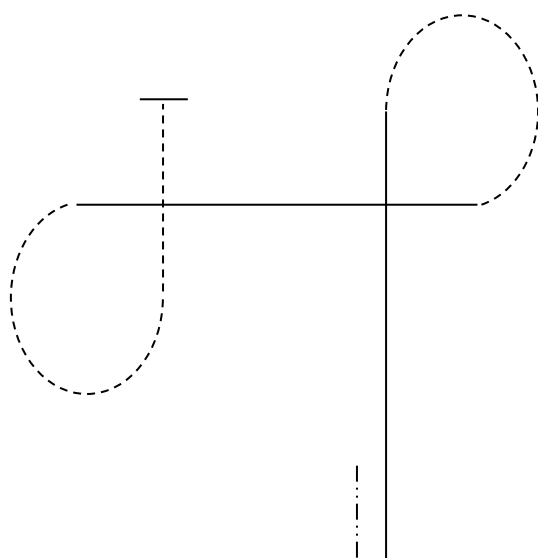

Be ready at start.
Back 4 steps.
Canter on the left lead
down quarter line.
Drop to a trot on the left
diagonal and circle to
the right.
Canter on the right lead
in a two-point position
across the center.
Drop to a sitting trot and
circle to the left.
Halt.
Walk to the lineup.

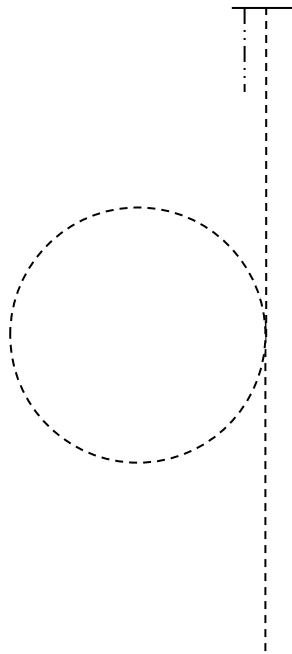

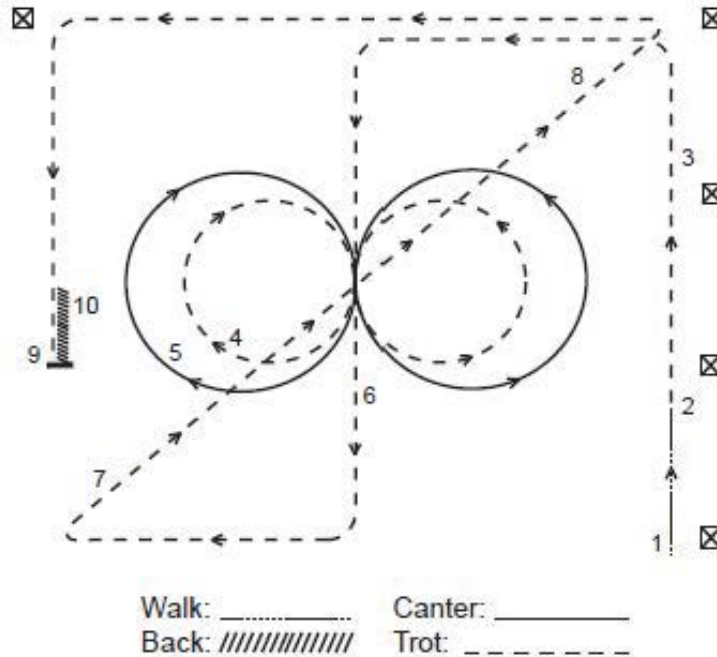

477. Pattern C – Level II English Control



1. Walk.
2. Sitting trot.
3. Working trot, rising.
4. Figure 8 at rising trot showing change of diagonal going to the right first.
5. Figure 8 at canter showing simple change of lead going to the right first.
6. Sitting trot.
7. Lengthened trot, rising demonstrating a change of diagonal while crossing center.
8. Working trot, sitting.
9. Halt.
10. Back.

Leave arena on a loose rein at the free walk.

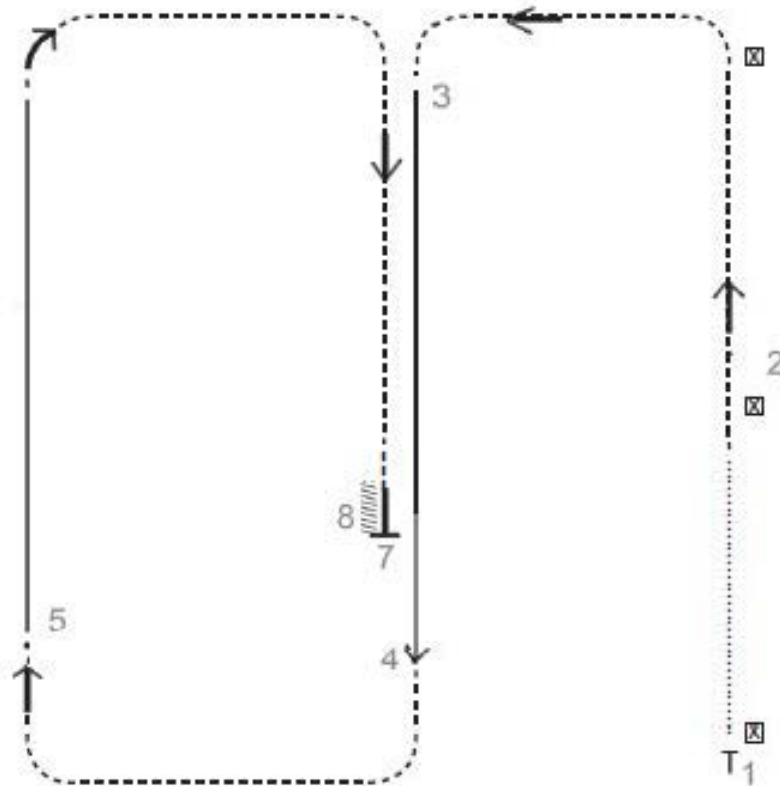
Markers 30 feet to 50 feet apart. Suggested arena size 150 feet by 200 feet.

475. Pattern A – Level I English Control

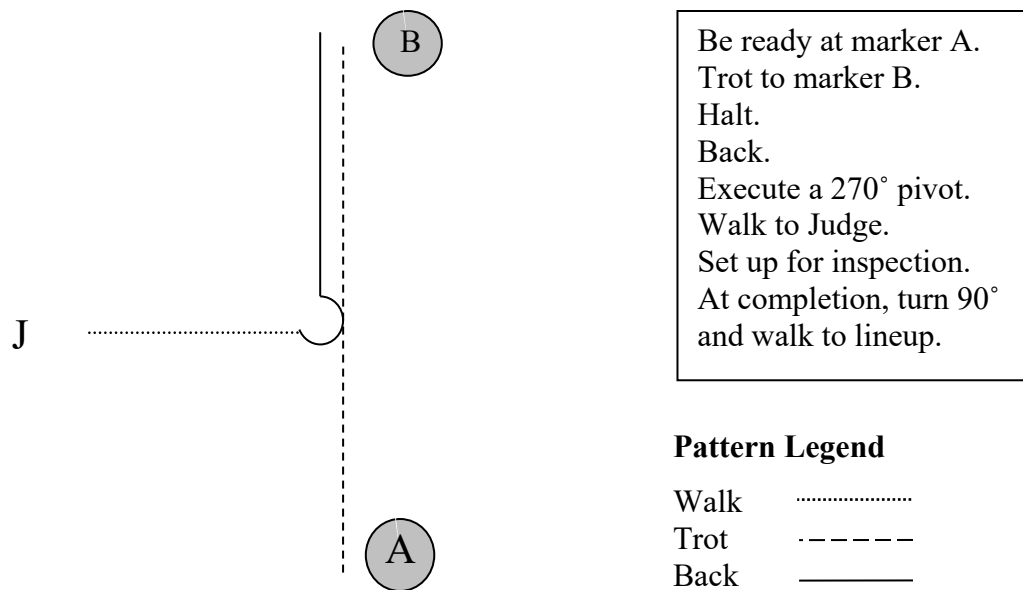


Walk: Canter: _____

2. Trot on the right diagonal.
3. Canter down center on the left lead.
4. Sitting Trot.
5. Canter on the right lead.
6. Posting trot on the left diagonal down the center.
7. Halt.
8. Back three steps.

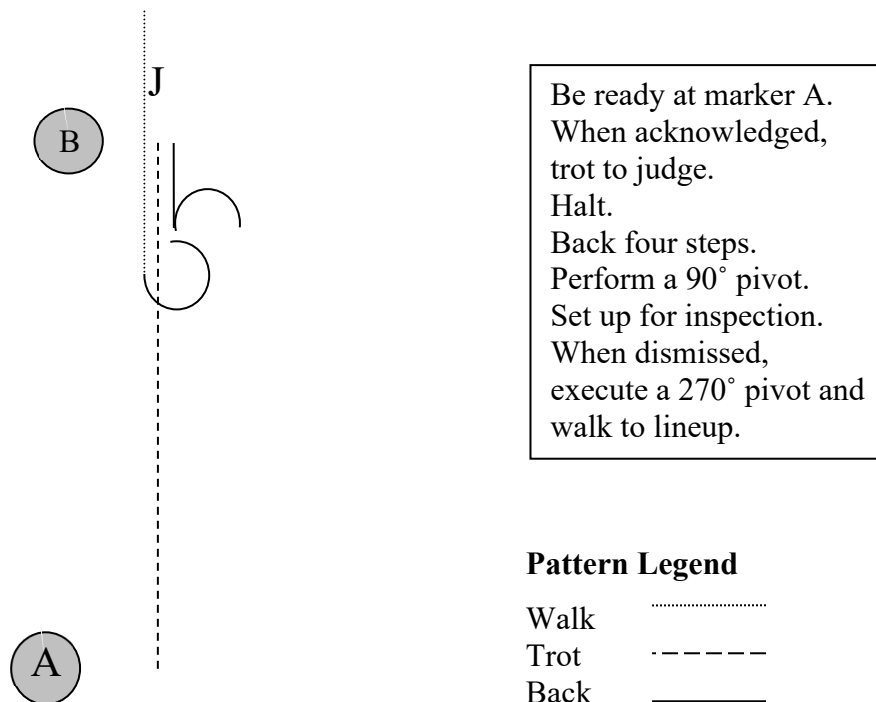

 Perform a square corner and continue up the rail.
 Halfway down rail, halt.
 Pivot 360° on the hindquarters to the left.
 Retrieve stirrups.
 Pickup lope and lope into center. Perform a figure 8 showing a lead change.
 Continue to lope.
 Halt.
 Back.
 Walk to lineup.

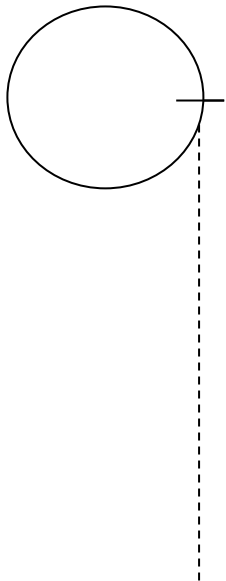

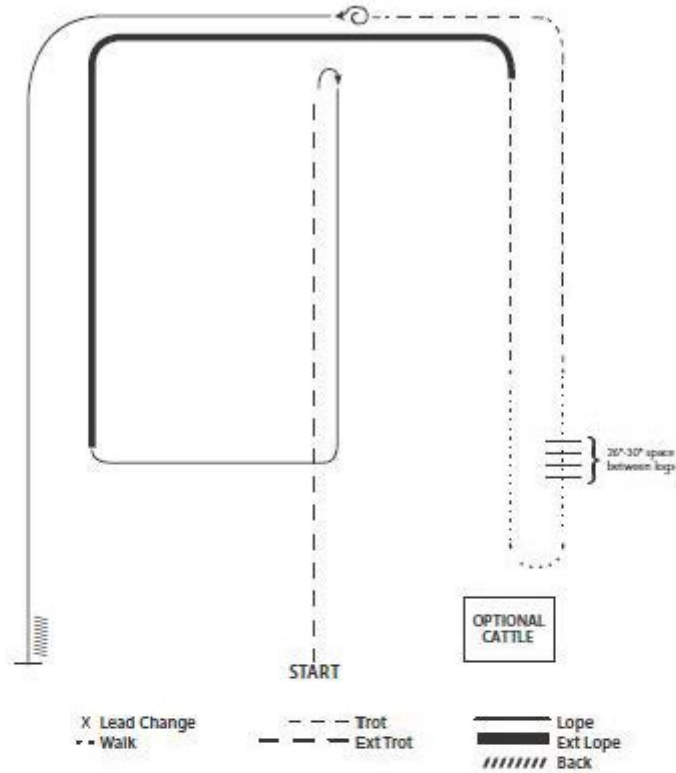

12. Stop and back

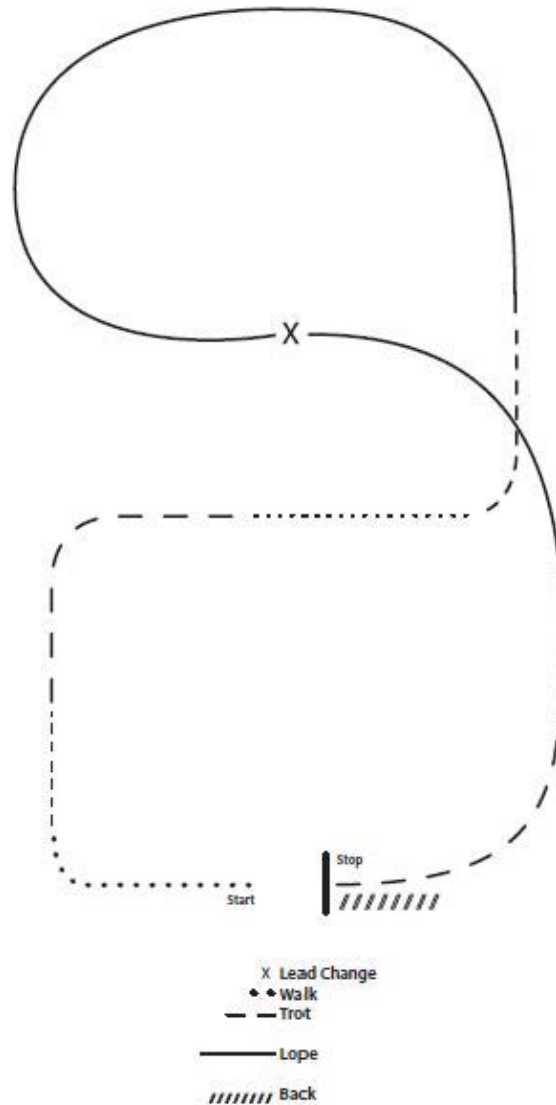

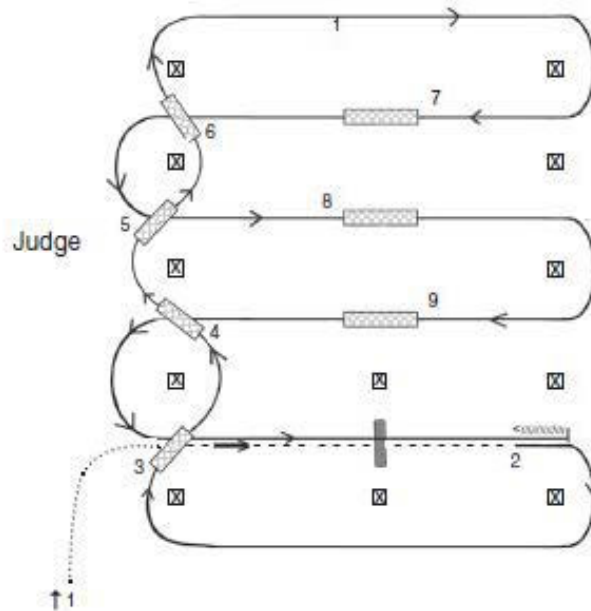

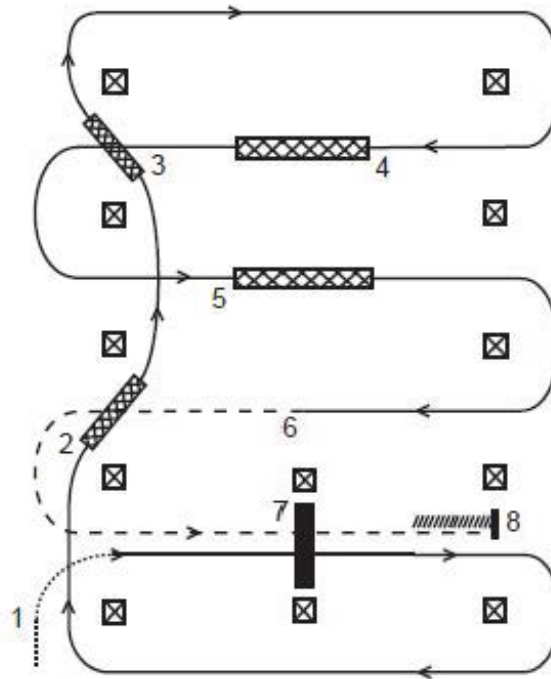

1. Walk, transition to lope, lope over log.
2. First line change.
3. Second line change.
4. First crossing change.
5. Second crossing change.
6. Transition to jog.
7. Jog over log.
8. Stop and back.

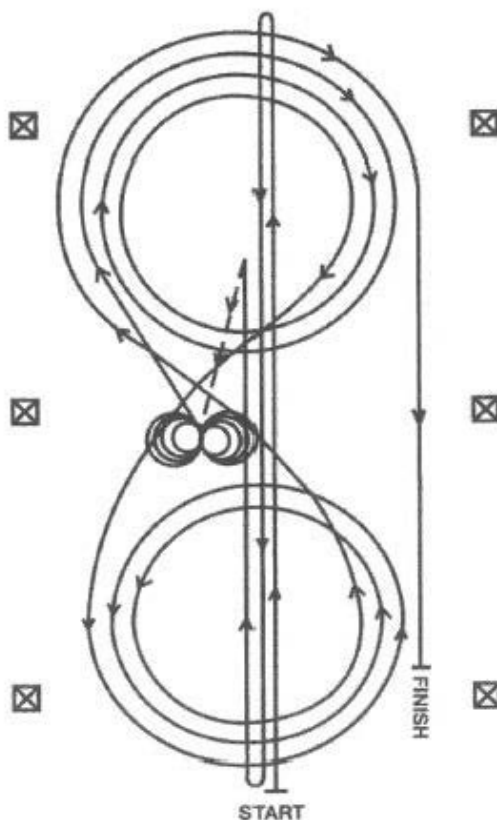

181. Pattern 5 – Level III and IV Reining (NRHA Pattern 7)



1. Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback – no hesitation.
2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback – no hesitation.
3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large fast circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

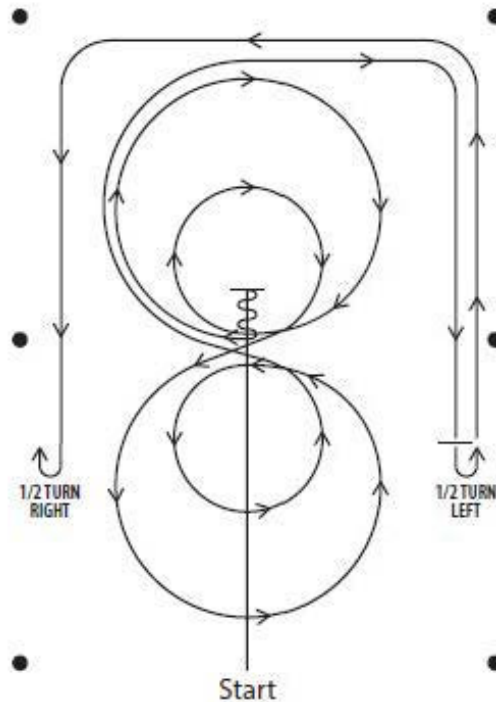
Rider must drop bridle to the designated judge.

172. Pattern I - Level II

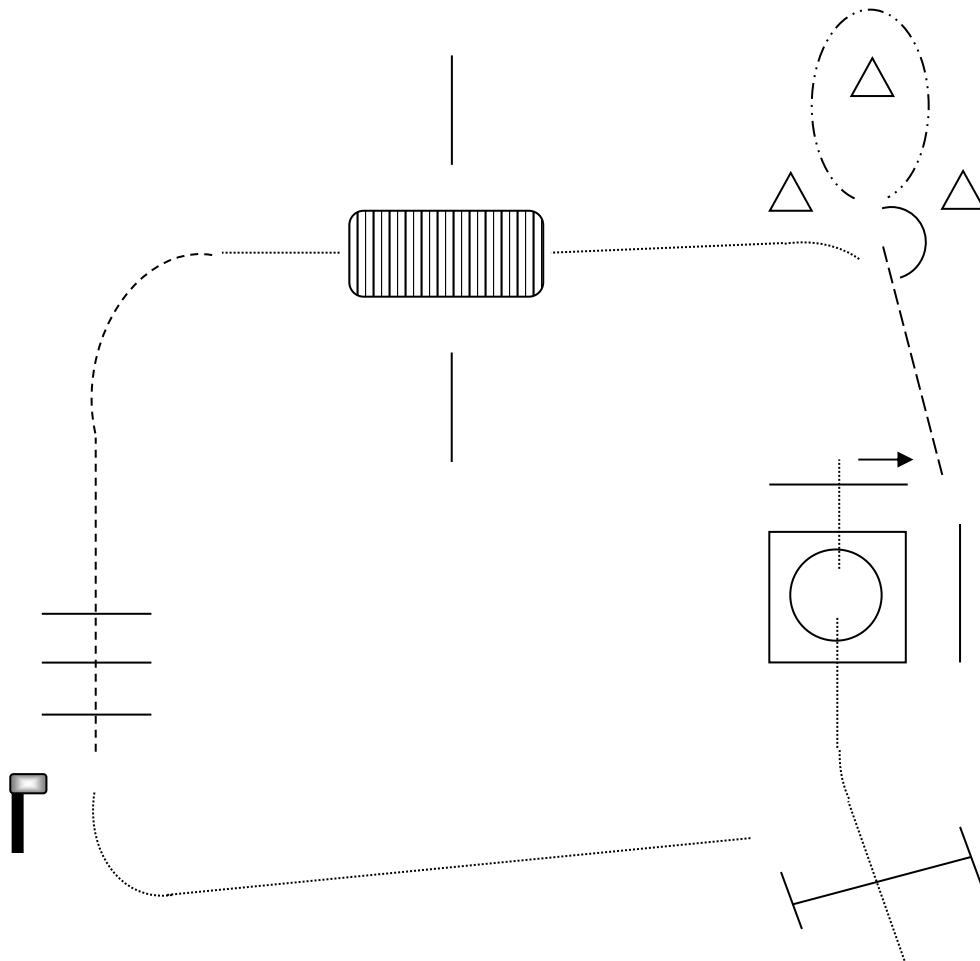
Proper execution of this pattern requires Level II advancement skills. All stops are balanced.

1. Start at end of arena. Run down middle past center marker to a balanced stop.
2. Back at least ten feet to center. 90 degree turn to the left.
3. Pickup right lead, large fast circle, small slow circle.
4. Simple lead change to left, large fast circle, small slow circle.
5. Simple lead change to right, do not close this circle.
6. Run around end of arena and down the side (approximately 20 feet from fence) past center marker and come to a balanced stop.
7. Turn 180 degrees on the haunches to the left.
8. Continue back down side and end of arena to other side (approximately 20 feet from fence) go past center marker and come to a balanced stop.
9. Turn 180 degrees on the haunches to the right. Hesitate to complete pattern.

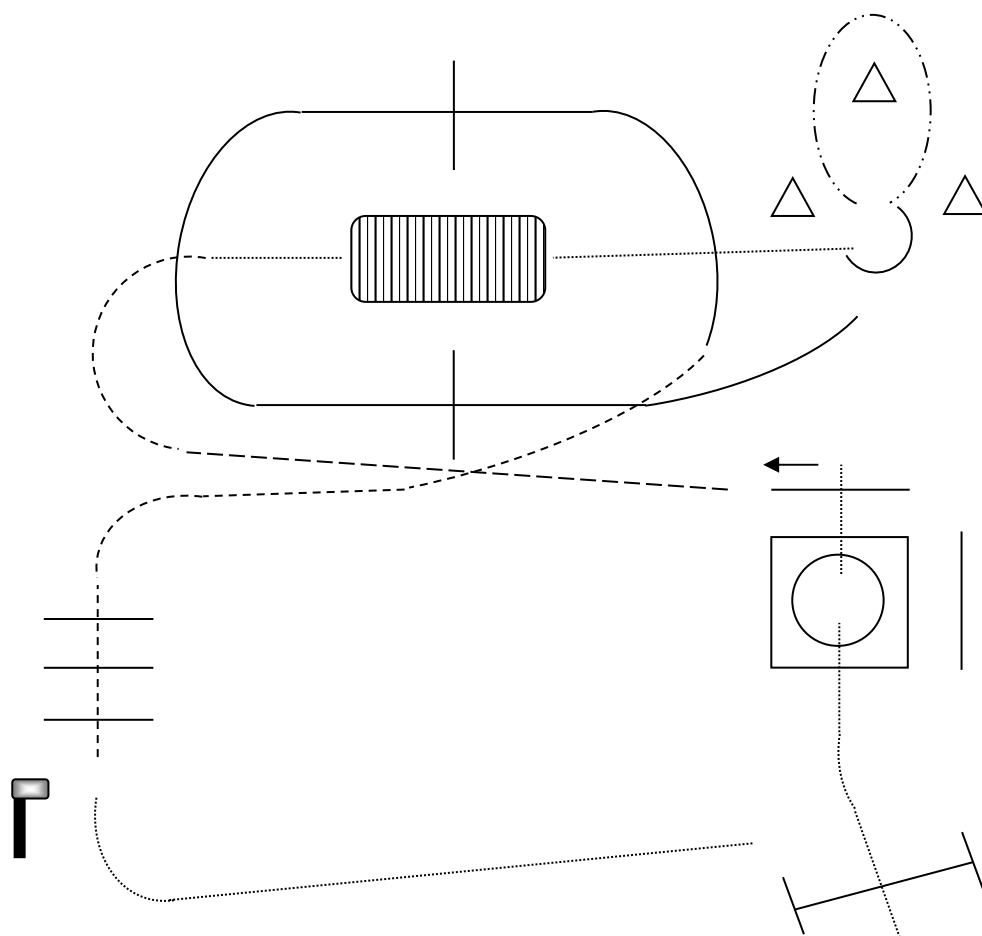

Perform a 180° turn to the right. Back as shown, either direction, around top cone. Walk to and over bridge. Trot to and over poles and up to mailbox. Halt. Open and close mailbox. Exit at a walk.

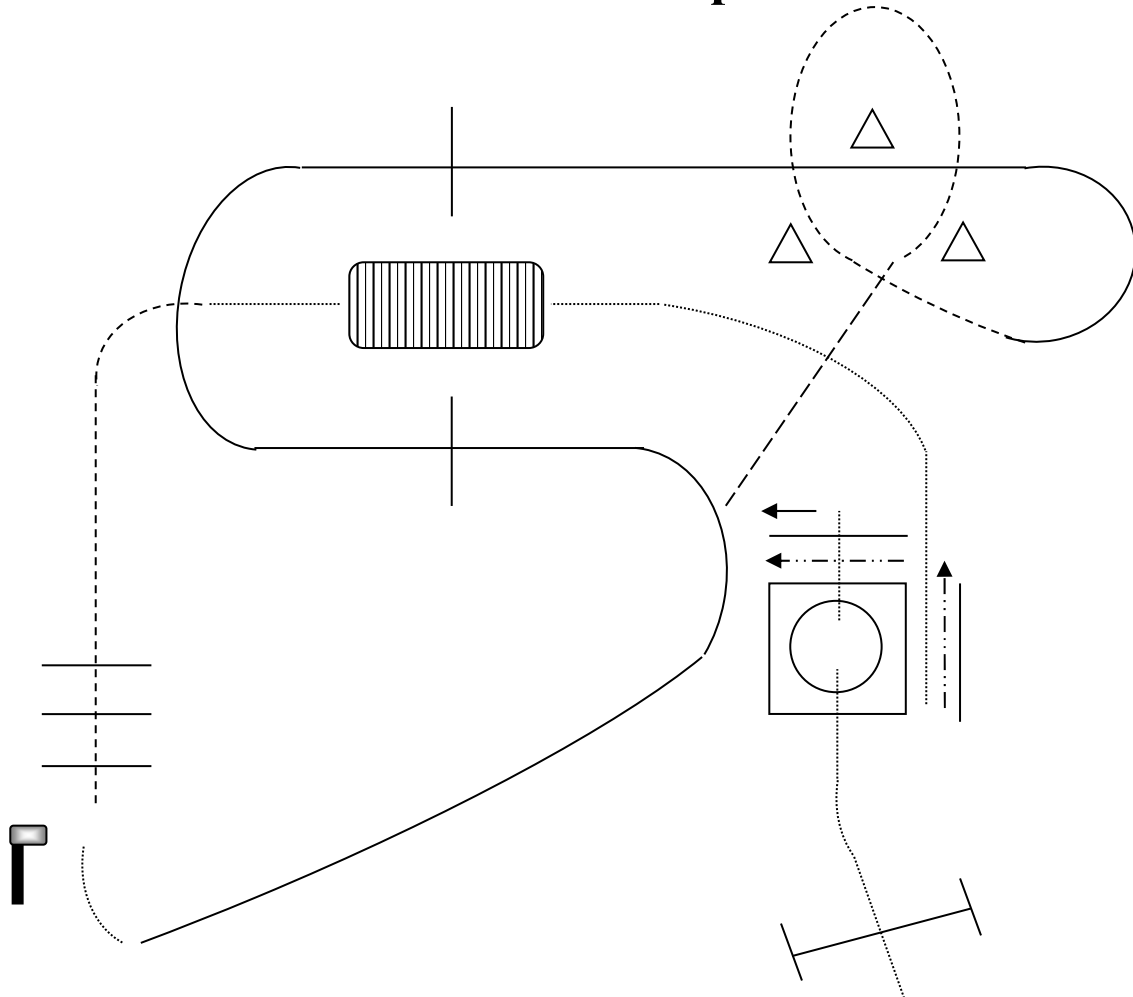

Trot to far side of bridge. Walk to and over bridge. Walk to cones. Turn and back thru cones, either direction, to circle top cone. Pick up right lead and canter over poles around bridge as shown. Trot to and over poles and up to mailbox. Halt. Open and close mailbox. Exit at a walk.

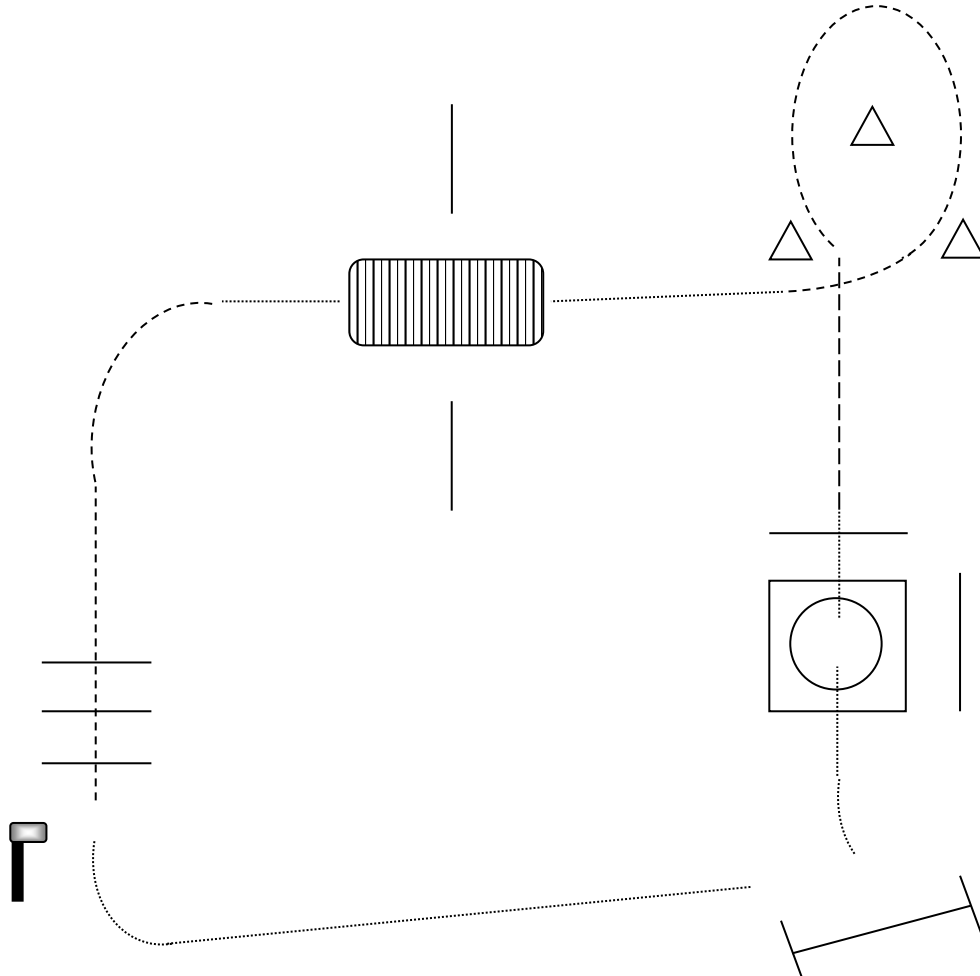

Jog cones as shown. Pick up left lead and lope poles on sides of bridge as shown. Change leads and lope to mailbox. Walk to mailbox and halt. Open and close mailbox. Jog over poles and toward bridge. Walk to and over bridge. Walk into chute. Back L. Halt to show completion and walk to exit.
